Career Options	
College/University Instructor	With a master's degree, teach at a part-time or adjunct level in college and university settings. Additional opportunities may exist at two-year, community colleges, through (online) distance education programs, and small private universities.
Teacher	Teach elementary, middle or high school students at public schools, with proper state certification. Opportunities without certification may exist at private or independent schools.
Training Manager	Provide worker training either in the classroom or onsite. Set up teaching materials, teach class and issue certificates of completion.
Training Specialist	Plan, organize, and direct a wide range of training activities, responding to corporate and worker service requests. Conduct orientation sessions and arrange on-the-job training for new employees. Help employees maintain and improve their job skills and help supervisors improve their interpersonal skills in order to deal effectively with employees. May set up leadership or executive development programs.
Training Specialist- Government Programs	Function as case managers by assessing the training needs of clients and guiding them through the most appropriate training method.
